- 2019 presidential elections & the nullification (High Court & Supreme Court)
- Protests against impunity & corruption
- Reforms & the change... that died!
  - Journalists exposing corruption & those holding dissident views targeted
  - Attorney General: snooping on those with dissident views

# President Chakwera's 2020 State of the Nation Address

# "As the world forges ahead into the future, we cannot afford to leave any child behind"

- Ending poverty and committing to "our Tonse [Alliance] cause of Gender Equality", implementing required gender quotas, localising gender laws (SDGs)
- <u>Too Large a Step to Take</u>: Gender & child protection disregarded in subsequent SONAs (2021 & 2022)
- <u>4 female ministers (17%);</u> 30% in 2022 against 40% (more deputies)



### WHERE IS THE GIRL-CHILD?

Corruption: "Malawi is a criminal enterprise", e.g. Vice President

2022 SONA (By President Chakwera) 2020-2021 Budget Statement: No mention of girl child/child protection

Investments in child protection remain very low (0.02%). What our Leaders can not commit or do... Worrying reports of CSE increasing



## MALAWI: THE WARM HEART OF...



Increasing reports of girls being raped

- A man repeatedly raped a 15 year-old girl child, infecting her with HIV. Granted bail (no measures taken on his engagement with under-aged girls) (30/06/2022)
- 30-year-old man raped a 10-year-old girl & infected her with HIV (2020).
- 12 men gang-raped a child
- **AFORD** (Alliance for Democracy): One of the parties in the ruling coalition appointed a suspected child rapist on bail to its NEC
